



GLAMORGAN CRICKET

**Cardiff City** are a professional association football club currently playing in the EFL Championship; however, they have brought Premier League football to the city twice in the last 10 years, most recently in 2019.

**Cardiff Devils** are a British Elite Ice Hockey League team and narrowly missed out on a third consecutive title in the final match of the 2019 season, they are the current reigning EIHL Playoff Champions.

**Cardiff Rugby** play at the famous Cardiff Arms Park and compete in the United Rugby Championship. Cardiff brought silverware home as recently as 2018 with their victory in the European Challenge Cup.

**Glamorgan Cricket** are the only first-class county team based in Wales and play their home matches at Sophia Gardens on the banks of the river Taff. Glamorgan clinched their first silverware for 17 years in 2021 as they won the Royal London Cup.


